It looks like it is going to rain.</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fixed arrangement in the near future <i>I am relaxing at home this weekend. (It's planned)</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Timetables <i>The bus arrives at 2 o'clock in the morning.</i> • Programmes <i>The film starts at 7 o'clock.</i>
